

Specifications packaging samples

- 1) The goods must be packed in good quality packaging.
 - The packaging must be strong enough to withstand normal shocks and loads during transport.
 - The packaging must be made and closed in such a way that vibrations or changes in temperature cannot cause loss of the contents.
 - During transport, there must be no (dangerous) residues on the outside of the Packaging.
- 2) The parts of the packaging that come into direct contact with the (dangerous) goods:
 - cannot be affected or noticeably weakened by it
 - are not able to react dangerously with it
 - must not allow permeation of the (dangerous) goods that could pose a hazard under normal transport conditions
- 3) If necessary, they must be provided with a suitable inner lining, additional packaging or an appropriate treatment.
- 4) The packaging is labeled in an unambiguous and correct manner.
- 5) The use of recycled food packaging (such as cola bottles) is not allowed.
